


We will discuss scales and planning, layouts and construction, and get some tips on how to create some beautiful scenery including mountains, tunnels, lakes and streams.



Lawrence Goodridge is a professional artist who lives and works in Northern Kentucky. In addition to his painting and illustration works, he creates custom model train layouts, dioramas, and displays. His favorite themes include Postwar America, the Old West, Ringling Brothers Circus and World War II. A recent layout features Patton's Third Army on the move in France in 1944, a tribute to history and to our veterans. His seasonal displays, clinics, and demonstrations share information about America's railroads and their role in the building of our nation.
